Currently, there is little to no competition. The furthest drive is just over 1 hour from Edmonton International Airport.

This is a terrific area. It was one of the few areas in Alberta to have bumper crops last year. There are 3 lakes (Red Deer, Sampson, Buffalo) and 2 major rivers (Red Deer, Battle River) in it with lots of major and minor potholes. Typical cereal crops and peas with corn becoming a major crop. Substantial flocks of Canada, speckle belly, snows, mallards, pintail, and wigeon. Occasional cranes. Shot fields of 5000-10,000 speckle belly day after day, last year. If you treat the farmers fairly you will not have much trouble getting permission. Best to do some leg work prior to the season and have a coffee with all the major landholders. It goes a long way.
