Alberta is home to a thriving population of record-class moose. The top six Canadian moose shot in Alberta have been over 220 inches, with the largest being a massive 226 7/8! Three are on the Boone and Crockett list of the top ten Canadian moose of all time. Safari Club International classifies the moose found in the southwest corner of Alberta as Shiras, where Alberta holds two of the top five, and four of the top twenty records overall! This and the fact you can hunt 365 days in any zone with your choice of weapon adds a whole different dimension to this one-of-a-kind licence. The terrain, hunting method, and size will depend on where in Alberta you hunt. Be it a fly-in tent camp, remote river canoe trip, a horse hunt in the mountains or a prairie hunt supported by ATV, the choices are all yours, depending on the experience you crave!

**New and improved terms and conditions are in place for this licence starting for 2023!** The purchaser of this licence will be authorized to hunt one (1) antlered moose anytime between September 1, 2023, and August 31, 2024. This licence **is valid** in Alberta, in any Wildlife Management Unit where a moose hunting season is identified in the 2023 Alberta Guide to Hunting Regulations. This licence does not authorize hunting in any location where hunting is prohibited as outlined in the *Wildlife Regulation* and the Alberta Guide to Hunting Regulations. Funds derived from the sale of this licence will be used to supporting Alberta's understanding of its wildlife resources, building up foundational management data through various wildlife inventory efforts.

## LICENCE CONDITIONS

The licence cannot be resold or transferred. The buyer can be an Alberta resident, a non-resident, or non-resident alien. If the licence holder is a non-resident or non-resident alien, they will be required to hire a licensed Alberta outfitter and be accompanied by a designated guide. To find an outfitter, the purchaser should visit the APOS website at [apos.ab.ca](http://apos.ab.ca). The cost for hiring the outfitter is not included in the sale price of the licence.

## NOTE

A 10% buyer's premium will be added to the final bid price of this special licence, which will be dedicated to the Dallas Safari Club (DSC). If the winner of this item refuses to pay the premiums required, the licence shall be offered to the next highest bidder for the price they bid.
